

SILVER BEAVER NOMINATION



WHAT IS THE SILVER BEAVER AWARD?

The Silver Beaver award is a national award presented by councils. Annually, the council Chairman will appoint a Silver Beaver Award Chairman and Committee who will consider candidates and make recommendations.

Former professional Scouters who worked for the council are not to be considered for nomination within 5 years of their leaving the profession. Nominations cannot be made for posthumous awards. The award is limited to adults 21 years of age or older. The requirements and procedures are as follows:

- This award may be made each year upon the nomination of chartered local councils. These nominations shall be submitted no fewer than 60 days in advance of the date upon which it is desired to present the awards.

- The award is made for noteworthy service of exceptional character to youth by registered Scouters within the territory under the jurisdiction of a local council. A minimum of 10 years is normally required as a Scouter.

- As evidence of the award there shall be presented: a suitable certificate, duly authenticated by the Boy Scouts of America, pursuant to the action of National Court of Honor; and a miniature Silver Beaver suspended by a blue and white ribbon to be worn around the neck.

- It shall be general policy that no public announcements shall be made by the local council in advance of action by the National Court of Honor with reference to names presented for consideration.

- These awards shall be made to the recipients by the local council in connection with its annual meeting or other suitable public functions.

- Each chartered local council shall be entitled to one nomination. Councils having more than 60 units shall be entitled to one Silver Beaver for every 60 units, or fraction thereof, registered by December 31.

- Councils not using their full allotment in any year may accumulate the unused portion for use in any subsequent year.

- In extraordinary cases, the Silver Beaver Award may be made by the National Court of Honor to a Scouter upon the recommendations of Scouting authorities who have supervision of one or more units of the Boy Scouts of America, located outside of the United States and not under the jurisdiction of a local council.
